

MISSOURI ENA PROFESSIONAL LEADERSHIP POLICY

- To define the expectations for Chapter Presidents and delegates within the Missouri State Council.
- To define the expectations for Committee Chairs and Co-Chairs within the Missouri State Council.

Approved: 11/2011

A. Procedure

- 1) Each chapter has the responsibility to provide active participation at the State Council level. Chapter delegates, State committee chairs & State Co-chairs serve as a vital link between the MOENA State Council and Chapters. It is the responsibility of the delegates to represent their respective chapters at MOENA State Council meetings in order to:

- Bring Chapter information and concerns to the State Council
- Take pertinent State Council information back to the Chapter
- Responsively provide communication, information and updates to membership

B. Chapter delegates: Chapter delegates shall be appointed by the Chapter to serve a one (1) year term, with any other limitations to be determined by the individual chapters according to Missouri ENA *Bylaws*. Each delegate must be a current active member of ENA and must attend a minimum of 50% of the State Council meetings according to Missouri ENA *Bylaws*.

C. Committee Chairs & Co-Chairs: State Committee Chairs and Co-Chairs are expected to attend a minimum of 50% of the State Council meetings.

D. Effective 2013, Failure of a chapter to have representation at 50% of the State Council meetings may result in chapter probation or revocation according to the MOENA Chapter Probation Policy.
